ADDENDUM TO THE DECISION TO IMPLEMENT AGGREGATE SPECTRUM CAP POLICY

This is an Addendum to the Decision to Implement Aggregate Spectrum Cap Policy dated the 16th day of September 2013.

The Decision to Implement Aggregate Spectrum Cap Policy is hereby amended as set out below:

1. Paragraph 14

The proposed aggregate cap for mobile/broadband spectrum (i.e. 700 MHz, 850 MHz, 900 MHz, 1800 MHz, and 1900 MHz) is 120 MHz. Upon due consideration of the propagation characteristics of these bands, it is the GoJ's view that at the level of 120 MHz there is sufficient capacity for existing operators to rollout out voice and data services to customers without stifling the market. The proposed level will also ensure that spectrum, in particular low band spectrum with the release of the 700 MHz spectrum, will be available for acquisition by new entrants and existing operators in order to expand their networks.

2. Paragraph 16

In light of the above, the decision has been taken to implement the spectrum cap policy effective immediately at the level of 120 MHz. The bands to be included in the calculation of the cap are the 700 MHz, 850 MHz, 900 MHz, 1800 MHz, and 1900 MHz bands.

Save and except for the foregoing all other provisions of the Aggregate Spectrum Cap Policy remain unchanged.
